We are grateful for all your gifts of time, resources, and partnership. This year **10,525 individual volunteers** contributed a total of **146,775 volunteer hours** and **12,816 donors** generously gave financial and in-kind **gifts totaling \$22,477,475**.

Twin Cities Habitat for Humanity is thankful for this broad community working together toward an equitable Twin Cities region where all families have access to the transformational power of homeownership.

## Individuals

Instead of listing individual donor names, we are highlighting the broad community of Twin Cities Habitat for Humanity supporters and the many ways you help make the mission happen.

**10,525 individual volunteers worked a total of 146,775 volunteer hours (16.8 years).** That time is valued at \$5 million according to the Independent Sector value of volunteer hours in MN!

**5,539 donors** made their first gift to Twin Cities Habitat, joining a collective total of **12,816 donors** committed to building the quality of life, health, and economic prosperity of our community through affordable homeownership.

**75 sponsors** made contributions to **kickstart 30 homes at The Heights** for the 2024 Jimmy & Rosalynn Carter Work Project. **2,252 enthusiastic volunteers representing 38 states contributed a collective 27,749 hours** to build homes, provide hospitality, and support during this historic week.

The Jimmy and Rosalynn Carter Work Project highlighted the **Volunteer & Learn program** with **15 homeowners** sharing their stories and **54 additional homeowners** volunteering on site throughout the week.

As the Twin Cities area continues to grow, securing land for Habitat home projects becomes more challenging. **Three individual and organizational donors made gifts of real estate**, creating a lasting impact for families through Habitat homeownership.

With help from the Leadership Council, we **hosted the fourth Family Volunteer Day** and welcomed dozens of families to our main campus to learn more about Habitat through activities and skill-building.

**41 AmeriCorps members** contributed a total of **15,715 hours**, serving as leaders on homebuilding sites and in-office roles assisting clients, volunteers, and staff.

Thank you to the **1,243 Builder's Circle members**. This group of individuals and family foundations build a brighter future for families and transform communities with annual gifts of \$1,000 or more.

**449 vehicles were donated** to Twin Cities Habitat's **Cars for Homes program**, where proceeds from vehicle sales will fuel Habitat's mission.

Celebrated the "retirement" of **five long-time regular volunteers** who were now welcomed into our Regular Crew Emeritus Group. Each had given **over 1,000 hours** of their time to our organization over the course of several years, some as many as three decades.

Nearly 1,000 supporters attended our **Hard Hat & Black Tie Gala**, and together they raised more than **\$1.2 million** to support local families through Habitat.

**Habitat on the Hill** returned to the Minnesota State Capitol, with more than **125 attendees** from Habitat affiliates across the state meeting with Minnesota legislators to advocate for affordable homeownership.

Thank you to the **96 Legacy Circle Members**, who have included Habitat in their will or estate plans, building an enduring impact through homeownership.

At our two **ReStore** Home Improvement Outlets, **75 regular volunteers** helped to turn **20,507 donations** from individuals and businesses into sales to support Twin Cities Habitat's mission.

**32 Women Build Team Leaders** brought their friends and family out to build with them, coming together on the homebuilding site to learn new skills, form community, and create affordable housing.

Thank you to the **926 monthly givers** whose gifts allow Habitat to more adequately budget and plan for the continuous need for affordable housing.

**Five individuals and families** stepped up to be the major sponsor of a Habitat house, making significant commitments to Habitat with the opportunity to see their generosity in action.

The second **Women of Habitat Mixer** was held at the Minneapolis ReStore with **over 80 attendees**. This event also kicked off the Women Build season, which recruited 32 team leaders for over 50 days onsite.

Through our **Global Impact Fund**, we contributed \$320,000 to Habitat International's global mission, serving **more than 71 families worldwide**. Additionally, hosted our **11th Global Village Gone Local** build week during Carter Work Project, highlighting our global partnerships at that milestone event.
