State Housing Tax Credit

Bill Numbers - HF3902 | SF4044

Support the extension of the State Housing Tax Credit Program and policy that prioritizes geographical balance. This is a critical tool for increasing the supply of affordable homes and strengthening public-private partnerships.



Reforming Homeowner Associations

Bill Numbers - HF1268 | SF1750

Support common sense reforms that increase transparency, communication, and oversight to ensure stability and fairness in homeownership. This bill provides needed consumer protections and improves the Homeowner Association (HOA) environment for homeowners and HOAs.



Starter Home Act

Bill Numbers - HF3895 | SF4123

Pass the Starter Home Act to allow for more homes, more choices, and lower costs. This enables developers to build more modest, affordable homes and reduce the delays and uncertainty that currently drive up construction costs.



Housing Infrastructure Bonds

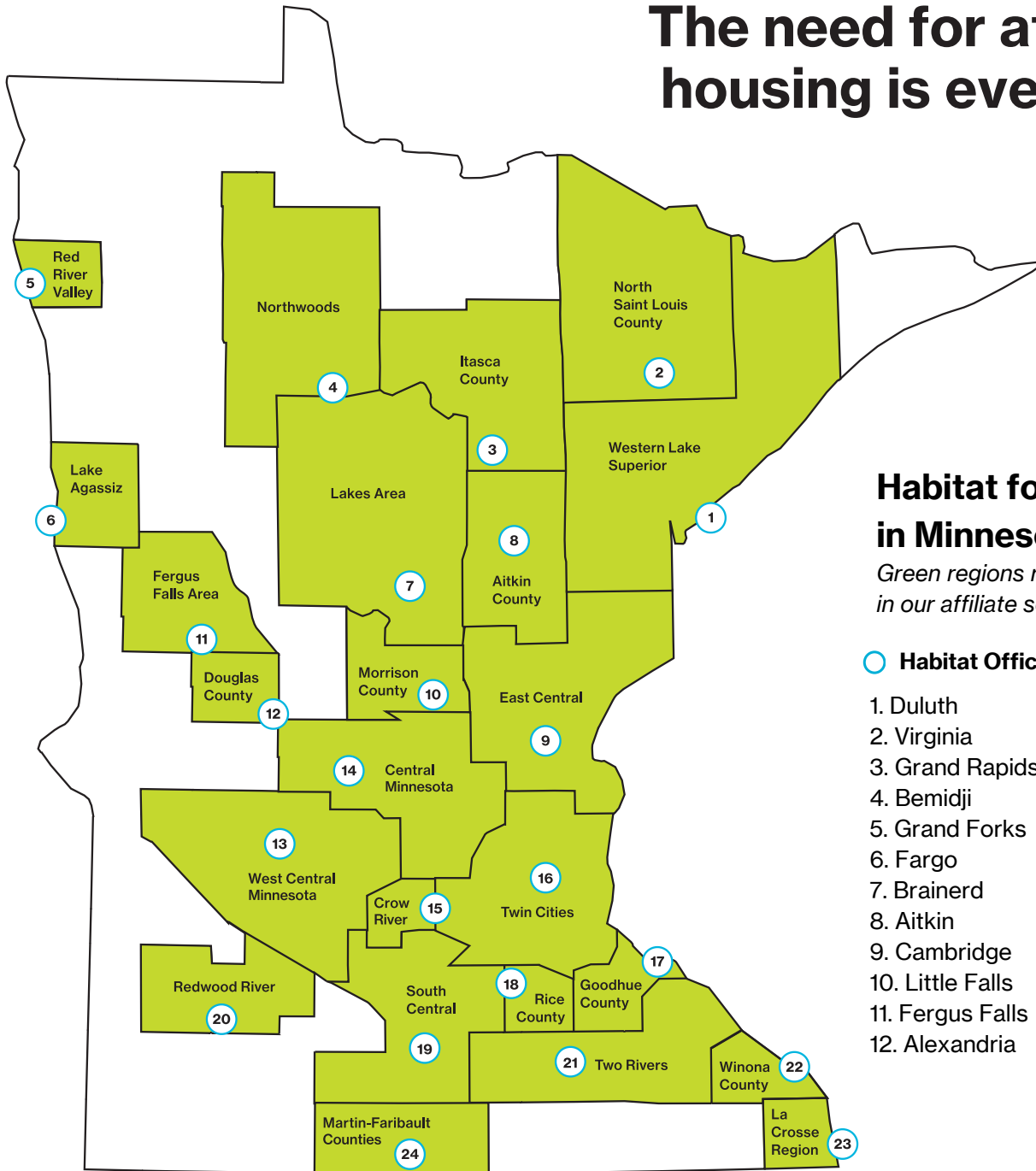
Bill Numbers - HF3806 | SF3839
