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Twin Cities Habitat to Break Ground on Ten New Units of Affordable Homes in Minnetonka

St. Paul, MN (June 1, 2026) – Twin Cities Habitat for Humanity, the largest affordable homeownership builder in the seven-county Minneapolis–Saint Paul metro area, will host a ceremonial groundbreaking on Wednesday, June 10, from 10 to 11 a.m. for the Minnetonka Mills Twin Homes project, developed in partnership with Homes Within Reach.

Construction is already underway, and the event marks the public launch of this development that will bring 10 for-sale homes to low- and moderate-income first-time buyers in Minnetonka. Media are invited to attend; the event is otherwise limited to stakeholders and invited guests.

The groundbreaking will take place at **13112 Inverness Rd., Minnetonka**, with parking available at Mills Church, 13215 Minnetonka Drive. The project transforms an underutilized parking lot on the church’s campus; preserves shared amenities such as an apple orchard and playground; and improves stormwater systems.

The Minnetonka Mills Twin Homes are projected to be completed in 2028. Funding for the project was provided by Congressionally Directed Spending, Minnesota Housing, contributors to the State Housing Tax Credit including Bridgewater Bank, Metropolitan Council, Hennepin County, the City of Minnetonka, individual donors, and a partial land donation from Mills Church.

“The Minnetonka Mills Twin Homes project significantly expands attainable homeownership options in Minnetonka,” said Twin Cities Habitat President Chris Coleman. “After robust community engagement, we are excited to celebrate this milestone and look ahead to welcoming ten families to their new homes.”
