**Youth Guidelines:**

For safety reasons, youth under the age of 14 are not allowed to volunteer at the ReStore. We require one adult leader for every group of four 14-15 year olds working at the ReStore. All adult supervisors must be 21 years of older.

Volunteers aged 16-17 do not need adult supervision, but will require a parental waiver. Volunteers will be prompted to sign this waiver when signing up.
