This letter will confirm that Twin Cities Habitat for Humanity with employer identification number 36-3363171, is considered a subordinate under the group tax exemption umbrella of Habitat for Humanity International, Inc. ("HFHI") under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
